I, the undersigned, acknowledge that parking is a privilege and not a right. I agree to abide by all the rules set forth in this St. Peter United Church of Christ (St. Peter UCC) Parking Permit.

RULES

1. Parking permits are issuable only to students who will be currently enrolled in Lake Zurich High School for the 2008-2009 school year and are valid for one school year.
2. Parking permits must be displayed in the lower portion of the driver side rear window of any permitted vehicle and vehicles must be parked forward into the assigned parking space.
3. Only one permit will be issued for each vehicle, and permits are not transferable to other students or vehicles.
4. The award of a parking permit by St. Peter UCC is a matter of discretion on the part of St. Peter UCC and creates no property right in the person to whom the permit is issued.
5. Students who have been issued parking permits by St. Peter UCC for the current school year shall be permitted to park vehicles valid displaying permits at the St. Peter UCC parking lot between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 5:30 P.M. Monday through Friday during the school year.
6. If a permitted vehicle is sold or becomes inoperable, the student must notify St. Peter UCC at the phone number shown below, which may issue a temporary parking permit to the permit holder for one (1) day only.
7. Each parking permit will pertain to an assigned parking space. Each vehicle may only be parked in the designated space.
8. St. Peter UCC parking lot parking permits remain the property of St. Peter UCC and must be surrendered upon request.
9. St. Peter UCC reserves the right to recall or revoke permits for any reason or no reason at all, to deny permits, to suspend permits, to close the parking lot and deny entrance to permit holders and to change this policy.
10. Vehicles which are parked in the parking lot which do not bear a valid sticker in the proper location or which are parked in the wrong location will be towed at the car owner's expense.
11. Permit holders operating vehicles in the lot shall possess a valid Illinois driver's license and the required insurance for the vehicle.
12. Permit holders entering and exiting the St. Peter UCC parking lot shall obey all speed limits and traffic laws, and shall not produce excessive noise (loud sound systems, squealing wheels, etc.)
13. Permit holders shall not deposit paper, garbage, food, beverages or debris in the parking lot or on any Township property.
14. Permit holders shall not loiter in the St. Peter UCC parking lot.
15. I agree to execute the Waiver and Release of all Claims related to St. Peter UCC parking program.
16. Permit holder is responsible for any rule violation made by passengers in their vehicle.
17. Driving more than 15 mph in the parking lot will not be tolerated.
18. Students who abuse the rules will receive one verbal notice. Continued actions will result in the parking sticker being revoked.
19. Areawide Recovery, Inc. will have the right to tow cars. The students will be held responsible for all fees incurred.

I further understand and certify that St. Peter United Church of Christ reserves the right to recall, revoke, or suspend my permit for a violation of the rules. This right shall be exercisable by any staff member or parishioner appointed to enforce the Parking Permit rules. I further understand that St. Peter United Church of Christ reserves any and all other rights it may possess by law to enforce property regulations regarding the St. Peter UCC Parking Lot.
